ORDINANCE NO. 780-24

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JUSTIN TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CITY GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 4, 2024.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Justin, Texas called an election held in the City on May 4, 2024, for the purpose of electing a person to fill the office of Three (3) Council Members, each elected to a two-year term respectively; and

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judge and other officials holding said election made the returns of the results thereof to the City Council as set forth herein, and said returns being made according to law, and duly authenticated, being shown that written notice of said election was posted for the time and manner provided by law, and all other proceedings pertaining to said election have been shown to have been done and performed at and within the manner provided by law, and all papers pertaining thereto having been returned and filed with the City Council and no protest or objection being made to or regarding any manner pertaining to said election; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized by law to adopt the provisions contained herein, and has complied with all the prerequisites necessary for the passage of this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, all statutory and constitutional requirements for the passage of this ordinance have been adhered to, including, but not limited to the Open Meetings Act and the Texas Election Code; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to promote the public health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Justin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JUSTIN, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That all matters stated hereinabove are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. That after examining the returns of the General Election held in the City on May 4, 2024, and opening and canvassing the votes of said general election that the results of said general election are as follows:

SECTION 3. That said election was duly called, that notice of said election was given in accordance with law, and that said election was held in accordance with the law, and that James Castle was duly elected Council Member Place 4, to a two-year term, that Daniel Dennis was duly elected Council Member Place 5, to a two-year term, and that Shelby Scott St. Claire was duly elected Council Member Place 6, to a two-year term. That the above named parties are hereby declared duly elected to those respective offices, subject to the taking of their oaths as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.

SECTION 4. That this Canvass and Declaration of Results of Election be entered in the minutes of the City Council and that said officers, after being qualified and having taken the oath, shall serve during the term commencing May __, 2024 and thereafter until a successor is duly elected and qualified.

SECTION 5. It is further found and determined that in accordance with the order of the governing body, the City Secretary posted written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located in the City Hall, a place convenient and readily accessible to the general public, and said notice having been so posted and remaining posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the scheduled time of said meeting.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

DULY PASSED AND ADOPTED, in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, by the City Council of the City of Justin, Texas, on this the 15th day of May, 2024.
